SUMMER DAY CAMP OVERVIEW LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

1. I understand that Day Camp begins at 8:30 a.m. and that my camper will be dismissed at 3:30 p.m. A bus will be in front of City Hall located at 117 E Joe P. Strickland, JR., Ave between 8:00 and 8:15 for your convenience. **Drop off at the South Sumter Middle School is between 8:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.** (with the exception of the children pre-registered for the before and after care program). **Pick-up is between 3:20 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.** at the South Sumter Middle School Gym (with the exception of the children pre-registered for the before and after care program). ****PLEASE NOTE: If your child is not pre-registered for the before and after care program, there will be a late fee of \$2.00 per 15 minute period that your child is picked up after 3:30 p.m.**

(SOME OF OUR TRIPS CALL FOR US TO LEAVE BY 8:45 A.M. PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT THE CAMPER IS ON TIME TO ENSURE THEY MAKE THE BUS.)

2. I understand and have signed a notarized field trip permission, medical treatment consent and a liability waiver.
3. I understand that there is **NO PRORATING** of days and there will be **NO REFUNDS** given for missed camp days unless a doctor's excuse is provided.
4. I understand no child can be released to anyone except custodial parents and/or those persons authorized on the registration form. For my child's safety, I understand there can be **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this policy. It is my responsibility to keep the City of Bushnell and the Day Camp Coordinator informed on any changes for authorized persons. A written notification must be sent if someone other than the designated persons is picking up your child.
5. Campers are expected to adhere to the attached camp rules.
6. I understand that no medication will be admitted without written permission from the parent/guardian and written instructions from a physician. All medications must be in the original container and prescribed to your child(ren).
7. All campers **must** wear gym shoes to camp activities. **No sandals allowed.** Parents will be called to bring proper shoes or to take the child home.
8. Campers are expected to supply adequate sunscreen and to adhere to the rules of the pool. Campers are encouraged to use bug repellent to outdoor excursions as we will sometimes be in woody environments.
9. Lunches – Campers need to bring their own lunch complete with a drink. We will provide campers with snacks every day. However you may pack snacks if you prefer.
