SUMMER DAY CAMP OVERVIEW LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

1. I understand that Day Camp begins at 8:30 a.m. and that my camper will be dismissed at 3:30 p.m. Drop off is between 8:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. (with the exception of the children pre-registered for the before and after care program). Pick-up is between 3:20 p.m. - 3:30 p.m. at the South Sumter High School Gym (with the exception of the children pre-registered for the before and after care program). **PLEASE NOTE: If your child is not pre-registered for the before and after care program, there will be a late fee of \$2.00 per 15 minute period that your child is picked up after 3:30 p.m.

(SOME OF OUR TRIPS CALL FOR US TO LEAVE BY 8:45 A.M. PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT THE CAMPER IS ON TIME TO ENSURE THEY MAKE THE BUS.)

- **2.** I understand and have signed a notarized field trip permission, medical treatment consent and a liability waiver.
- **3.** I understand that there is NO PRORATING of days and there will be NO REFUNDS given for missed camp days unless a doctor's excuse is provided.
- 4. I understand no child can be released to anyone except custodial parents and/or those persons authorized on the registration form. For my child's safety, I understand there can be NO EXCEPTIONS to this policy. It is my responsibility to keep the City of Bushnell and the Day Camp Coordinator informed on any changes for authorized persons. A written notification must be sent if someone other than the designated persons is picking up your child.
