In an effort to educate the public concerning the issue of "Publicly Owned and Operated Electric Utility Providers," The Bushnell City Council adopted a municipal electric scholarship program to award one graduating senior with a \$500.00 scholarship for any Florida University, Community College, or Vocational School.

The scholarship shall be used for tuition purposes, and may not be used for books. This scholarship may be utilized for any year or semester the student wishes to apply the awarded funds. The scholarship funds will be paid directly to the registrar of the institution desired.

Applications for the scholarship **must be submitted to the City on or before April 17**<sup>th</sup>.

## **REQUIREMENTS TO QUALIFY:**

- Dependent who <u>resides in the home of a city electric customer</u>
- 2.5 GPA minimum
- Graduating Senior Class of 2017
- Minimum two page summary of topic:

- 2. **Organization**: Ideas should be logically developed and show critical thinking. The conclusion should thoughtfully complete the essay.
- 3. To produce a high quality essay you need to demonstrate your ability:
  - to understand the precise task set by the title.
  - to identify, appropriate material to read;
  - to understand and evaluate that material:
  - to select the most relevant material to refer to in your essay;
  - to construct an effective argument;
  - to arrive at a well-supported conclusion.
